POSITION TITLE: Maintenance Mechanic

PRINCIPAL RESPONSIBILITIES: Performs all aspects of maintenance and preventive maintenance on production equipment, building equipment, office equipment, building and grounds to ensure quality and efficiencies for the organization are met.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Provides preventive maintenance to maintain efficient equipment operation. Assists in the maintenance and repairs of production equipment

Provides HVAC maintenance and troubleshooting.

Provides general building maintenance including but not limited to snow removal, ground maintenance, general building maintenance, and painting.

Keeps maintenance log as required.

Keeps maintenance supervisor advised of equipment spare parts needed.

Coordinates with department supervisors when machines must be taken offline for maintenance.

Works on high voltage electrical equipment and wiring to perform repair and installations.

Oversees contractor work for facility modification and repair.

Is trained and works in compliance with all plant and departmental standard operating procedures and safety procedures.

Maintains plant safety systems so that they are operational.

May assist in maintenance duties at other LHB locations.

MARGINAL FUNCTIONS:

Other duties as assigned.

PHYSICAL/VISUAL ACTIVITIES OR DEMANDS: Able to lift up to 50 pounds.

WORKING CONDITIONS: Generally, indoors, some outdoor (hot and cold) exposures, some work on roof.

KNOWLEDGE:

Knowledge of electronics, electrical services, hydraulics, pneumatics, HVAC required.

Strong knowledge of general mechanics and machine operations.

Knowledge of aerosols and liquid filling preferred.

Knowledge of high voltage services required.

EXPERIENCE:

Technical School Graduate (Maintenance Management or

equivalent), and/or minimum 3 years of experience in a manufacturing environment, performing equipment/building repairs and line set-up. Experience with aerosol production a plus. Process logic controls/electronic expertise a plus. Project management experience a plus.

SKILLS AND ABILITIES: Troubleshooting and equipment repair, general construction, plumbing, welding, HVAC and carpentry skills. Forklift Operation. Ability to read schematics/diagrams. Ability to work on high voltage installations and electronics (PLCs, circuit boards, etc.). Universal Gas License preferred.
