POSITION TITLE: Paint Set Up Operator

REPORTS TO: Production Supervisor/Production Manager

PRINCIPAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

Responsible for the proper setup of all products in an efficient manner to minimize downtime.

Responsible for operation and control of the still operation and maintaining all hazardous waste logs.

Responsible for safe handling of all materials and equipment.

Responsible for maintaining clean and safe work environment.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Reads the formula sheet prior to starting each run and makes sure the correct paint and solvents are being utilized for each run.

Makes the necessary adjustments, complex and routine, to keep fill room operating efficiently with limited assistance. Oversees all operations in the small batch room, paint mix room and aerosol fill room.

Moves paint and solvent drums to the paint mix room for mixing.

Moves empty drums to empty drum storage area or onto empty drum trailer.

Mixes the liquids in each drum for 30 minutes and checks to make sure there aren't excessive solids in the bottom of the drum.

Maintains all equipment, (hoses, pumps, mixers, etc.), in a clean and safe manner. Follows all departmental Work Instructions.

Monitors and changes all paint filters and observes pressure drops in the paint line.

Maintains strict housekeeping and safety practices.

Maintains distillation operation and the recording of all data in the hazardous waste log.

May work daily overtime to ensure line is ready to run by the start of normal operations.

Cleans lines out at the end of a run and may work on weekends.

Labels hazardous waste drums and logs the necessary information on the drum label and in the hazardous waste log.

Makes sure all pumps, drums, and filling lines are properly ground.

Other duties as assigned.

KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS:

Must have ability to comprehend basic workings of machinery.

Must be mathematically inclined.

Must be able to read scales and formula sheets.

Must be able to clean lines and equipment including gassing and batching areas.

Must be able to move 600-pound drums, totes, and skids of paint in a safely manner.

Must be able to check paint drums for skinning prior to mixing.

Must follow written Work Instructions and possess a high degree of quality in work.

MINIMUM EXPERIENCE AND EDUCATION:

High School diploma or GED preferred.

Prior manufacturing and/or machine operation experience preferred.

PHYSICAL/VISUAL ACTIVITIES OR DEMANDS:

Visual acuity is required for work performed in the gassing house.

Must be able to use a drum cart while moving a 600-pound drum.

WORKING CONDITIONS:

Observes and follows safety regulations and always displays the ability to perform job functions in a safe manner.

May start shift one hour prior to production startup to get paints mixed and to the line.

Finish shift at the end of production day and clean out line for the next day.

Must wear safety equipment in the designated areas.

Required to work overtime as required by the manufacturing operation.

Must be able to tolerate nuisance level solvent odors. Fume concentrations are well below OSHA permissible levels. (Individuals with asthmatic conditions may experience discomfort in this environment).

Must walk up and over staircase to the gashouse.
